These have included the Textile Clothing Footwear Resource Centre Inc. (TCFWA), Belmont Small Business Awards, WA Racing Industry Development Project, Designedge Innovation Festival, Multicultural Business Support Services, Designedge Fashion Incubator, Belmont Clothes Library, and Business Workshops for Youth.

Other centre activities include the establishment of a range of specialist business workshops, many with a focus on creative industry business development programs with indigenous and culturally diverse groups.

“As the only BEC in Australia specialising in fashion and creative industry micro small business support, our resources are continually stretched to the limit with the thousands of emails we receive and send in WA and nationally,” said Ms Hanlon.
