In 2014, after recognising a gap in the market for quality building certification services, Kasey established Elite Compliance – which delivers compliance management and approval services to the construction industry.

Prevention of Family and Domestic Violence in particular, is at the heart of Elite's core values. Kasey has committed to design and manage the construction of a new purpose-built crisis accommodation facility in Kalgoorlie that will deliver 44 new beds to the existing women's refuge. Kasey has already raised \$1.45million for the Hope Foundation Refuge expansion project.
