

How to fire a bad client (politely)

Quick tricks in Excel

- * To add more rows in an Excel spreadsheet, click on the row above where you want to add more rows, then hold Alt I and R. To keep adding more rows, each time you press the F4 key, it will add another row easy!
- * If you have several columns of names and want them combined into one column, try this in the top cell of the column to feature all the names, type =TOCOL / open parenthesis (/ highlight all the names in the columns / close the parenthesis) DONE!



Windows 10 is no longer supported by Microsoft - options

You CAN keep using Windows 10, even beyond October 2025, with Microsoft's Extended Security Updates (ESU) program. This video shows you step-by-step how to enrol your Windows 10 PC, the different options available, and what this means if your device isn't eligible for Windows 11.
