SMS sender ID register

The way businesses and organisations send branded text messages is changing. From 1 July 2026, new rules mean texts sent with an organisation's name at the top of a message (known as a branded sender ID) will need to have the sender ID registered.

Product safety: what businesses need to know

In Australia, businesses must make sure the consumer products they sell are safe to use. This is part of the Australian Consumer Law. Businesses must:

- not sell or supply unsafe or banned products
 - follow safety and information standards
 - notify regulators of serious injuries, illnesses, or deaths linked to a product.
- If you're not sure if a product is subject to a [permanent ban](#) or complies with [relevant standards](#), it may be safer to stop selling it. [More detail](#).

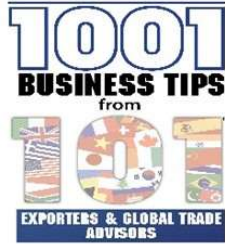

Small businesses face higher wage bills from July

Small and medium businesses are facing higher wage bills after the Fair Work Commission hiked award rates to help 3 million Australian workers cope with rising living costs. The national minimum wage will rise by 6% and modern award rates by 4.75% on July 1 – the same day new [Payday Super](#) laws come into effect. The [Annual Wage Review](#) decision affects around 1 in 5 workers, concentrated in sectors where SMEs dominate: hospitality, retail, healthcare and administrative services. [Article](#).

Unsolicited business name renewal and company review notices

ASIC is alerting companies and business name holders to unsolicited letters, emails and notices from third-party service providers about company annual reviews or business name renewals. ASIC is aware that these materials may cause confusion as being authorised or sent by ASIC. These providers are not ASIC. Some may be ASIC-registered agents, which are businesses that can act on behalf of a company, where the company has provided authorisation, to assist with ASIC-related tasks, such as lodging documents and keeping company details up to date. However, they may charge an extra fee for these services in addition to the fees charged by ASIC. [Details](#).

To highlight a row or column – Click on View, then Focus cell – then, every time you click somewhere, the appropriate row/column will be highlighted ... you can even change the colour of the highlight.

To insert the current date, hold Ctrl and ;

To insert the current time, hold Ctrl, Shift and ;

To highlight particular cells in a spreadsheet – highlight all cells, hold Alt and type HLHE, then enter the cell details you want highlighted and the colour.

To open what you've been working on, press the Windows key and Tab.

If you have multiple pages open on your desktop and want to minimise them, press Windows key + D.

Quick tips using Microsoft Word

To instantly convert text to a table – highlight the text and click Alt then N T I.

To create a double line across a page – type = three times, then Enter.

For a single line across a page – type - three times then Enter

For a dotted line across a page- type * three times then Enter.

To add bullet points – highlight the lines and press Ctrl Shift and L.

On-screen keyboard – Windows key and R. Type osk. OK
